First Lutheran Church Matching Funds Scholarship Policy

Purpose:

In an effort to support the mission of the Lutheran Colleges of the ELCA and provide an incentive for confirmed members of First Lutheran Church to attend ELCA colleges, First Lutheran church will provide scholarship support to those students who are accepted by or are attending ELCA Lutheran colleges.

Eligibility:

Only confirmed members of First Lutheran Church are eligible for this scholarship support. They must be accepted for admission or enrolled in an ELCA Lutheran college. They can receive the support for more than one year if they are making satisfactory progress toward a degree (per academic standards established at each college).

Selection Process:

Eligible students should submit a request to the First Lutheran Scholarship Fund committee by June 1st for the following academic year.

First Time Applicants:

- Applicants name, address, phone number and email address.
- A copy of the letter from an ELCA college indicating the applicant has been accepted for admission.
- A copy of the colleges matching scholarship funds requirements if available and the amount of funds that the applicant is requesting.
- A written statement explaining why s/he wants to attend that college and what the applicant expects the educational experience will contribute to the individual's future calling, profession, life and faith.

Repeat Applicants Must Include:

- Applicant's name, address, phone number and email address.
- A copy of the colleges matching scholarship funds requirements and the amount of funds that the applicant is requesting.
- Comments about academic performance that will demonstrate that the applicant is making satisfactory progress toward graduation (e.g. number of credit hours per term, grade point average).
- A written statement detailing what the Christian higher education has meant to their faith and personal development, specific experiences that have enriched their lives, and what they expect to learn and experience in the future academic year.

Scholarship Fund Awards:

In any year, the First Lutheran Scholarship Committee will review the applications and make recommendations to the Council for scholarship support for each applicant by June 1. Council approval is necessary for funds to be allocated. Only those funds designated to the Scholarship Fund will be allocated. Funds allocated will be sent to the college by August 1.

The amount to be awarded to each individual student will depend on these factors:

- The number of students requesting funds.
- The amount of funds available in the fund.
- The amount that each student has requested. They may request up to the amount of the matching grant limit indicated by the college they attend. An effort will be made to fund each student to the amount they request up to the maximum amount that each ELCA collage will match. Awards will be of equal amount for all students applying.

Scholarship Fund Raising:

The Scholarship Fund committee will facilitate fundraising efforts to support this fund and will encourage congregational giving to the fund by First Lutheran Members. The Church Council can make yearly budget contributions to the fund if they choose.

Scholarship Committee:

The Scholarship committee shall consist of no less than 3 and no more than 5 members. Committee members must be members of First Lutheran Church and not be family members of applicants who are presently seeking scholarship funding. Committee members will be approved by the Church Council. The committee will meet no less than twice a year. Once in the fall to set funding goals and facilitate the fund raising efforts and following the May 1st application deadline to determine scholarship awards and make recommendation to the Church Council for scholarship allocations.
